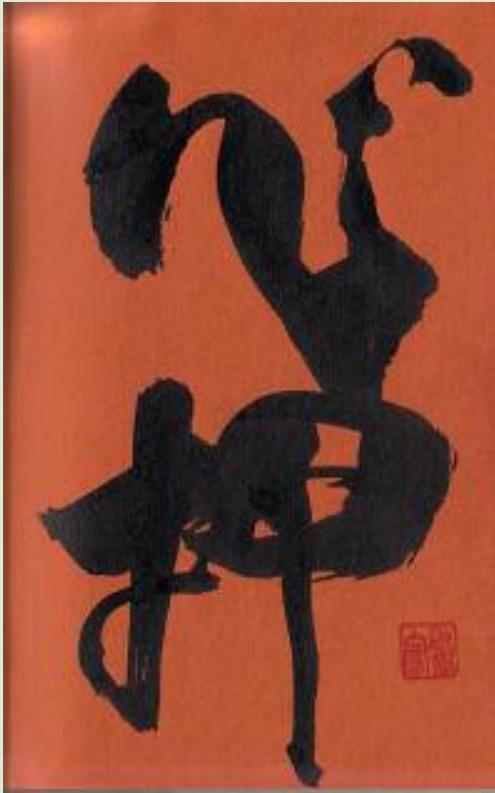

Shinden Jutsu Practitioner Level Course

Amatsu UK Ltd is offering on going training to a third year level in Shinden Jutsu. This art is described by Dr. Hatsumi as being the Heart of Amatsu.

It approaches the body as a whole person combining the Visceral-Skeletal-Muscular and Ligaments systems as one moving working unit.

In Shinden Jutsu the Practitioners Natural Movement skills are a important as the Clients.

Dr. Hatsumi describes this as the Essence of the Art sharing the same fundamental feel both in the Budo and the Medicine

The format of the course is three, five-day blocks with a one day examination. The Course will commence on the 6th to the 10th of September 2004. The course is limited to 12 people and will be held in Hartlepool, the North East Centre of the Country.



Two Five Day Workshops will cover:

- The Ligaments of the Body
- The Paralateral Ligament Intelligence
- Spinal Dynamics
- Detailed Anatomic Organ Positions
- Organ, Ligament attachments
- The Visceral Web of the Body
- Musculo-Skeletal Connections of Lesion Patterns.
- Amatsu Organ Reflex Technique Approach
- Organ, Ligament, Spinal Evaluation, Palpation and Diagnosis.
- Limbic Brain Evaluation
- Reflex Gait Patterns
- The Anthropology of the Upright Human Biped.

The final five-day workshop is in groups of four practitioners working in depth with Dennis, to develop the feel for Shinden. This is an intense hands on experience designed to mould your modelling skills to the application of this approach. Applicants must have two years of tuition in Amatsu Principles.
